- Port Everglades will be fully reopened.
- South Florida Container Terminal will reopen Wednesday, September 4th at 0700 hrs for truck gates and vessel operations.
- Port of Miami terminals are fully operational. Trucking operations in the Miami area have resumed for the spotting and pick up of equipment. However, all other intermodal for cargo via Miami remains suspended due to the projected path of the storm. The railroad service remains suspended until further notice

Savannah, GA – Garden City Terminal is CLOSED Wednesday 9/4 Charleston, SC – CLOSED Wednesday 9/4 and Thursday 9/5, plans to RE-OPEN at 9:00 am on Friday 9/6

Jacksonville, FL – Port CLOSED Wednesday 9/4
